III. God's Work Through Us - "Good Works"

• Grace tells us that we are not saved by "good works", but we are saved to do good works.

[10] For we are his <u>workmanship</u>, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

Greek: Poiema- we are his craftsmanship, "God's POEM"

What poem is Jesus writing in the lives of his people?

It is a poem of redemption & renewal, of restoration & revival.

We live in a "throwaway" culture.

- patches on torn jeans
- Creator of red solo cup died this week

Illustration- Kintsugi

- ("golden repair") is the centuries-old Japanese art of fixing broken pottery with a special lacquer dusted with powdered gold, silver, or platinum.
 - Beautiful seams of gold glint in the cracks of ceramic ware, giving a unique appearance to the piece.
 - This repair method celebrates the artifact's unique history by emphasizing the fractures and breaks instead of hiding or disguising them.
 - Kintsugi often makes the repaired piece even more beautiful than the original, revitalizing the artifact with new life.
 - It is related to the Japanese philosophy of wabi-sabi, which calls for finding beauty in the flawed or imperfect.
 - The repair method was also born from the Japanese feeling of mottainai, which expresses regret when something is wasted.

What a beautiful picture of the Gospel!!!!!

<u>Illustration</u>: Take our Lintsugi Bowl from Box

- At the beginning God formed Man by he reaching into the dirt and formed us with his bare hands
- Now Jesus reforms us by taking the broken pieces of our lives and putting by together
 - He uses a much more precious and value resource then gold, His blood.
